**Summary of funding decisions made by the Panel during December 2007**

1. Application 287: Major Energy Users Inc (EMRF, ECCSA, EUCV & MEG Tasmania) - Review of guidelines for the NSW distribution transitional review by the AER  
The application for funding of \$11,088 excl GST was approved.
2. Application 288: Ethnic Communities Council of New South Wales - NEM advocacy and capacity building to represent ethnic communities  
The application was deferred in order that the Panel could work with the applicant to refine the project so it clearly identifies the issues they wish to advocate on and is focused it on issues in the NEM that impact on ethnic communities.
3. Application 289: Energy Users Association of Australia - AEMC review of demand side participation in the NEM  
The application for funding of \$51,000 excl GST was approved in principle subject to the applicant reviewing the AEMC's statement of approach and providing a revised budget that takes into account the statement of approach and more specific details of the outputs and outcomes of the project.
4. Application 290: Major Energy Users Inc (EMRF, ECCSA, EUCV & MEG Tasmania) - AER review of guidelines for distribution and service target performance  
The application was approved for funding of \$20,160 excl GST.
